Artisan's Blend -

Chardonnay Pinot Grigio 2011



Region: Murray Darling, Victoria.

Varieties: Chardonnay 85%, Pinot Grigio 15%

Harvest: Pinot Grigio & Chardonnay - Mid-February.

Vinification: Grapes were harvested when the primary fruit flavours were abundant. Both the Chardonnay and the Pinot Grigio underwent a slow and cool fermentation and were kept separate to ensure greater options when deciding the final and most satisfying blend.

Wine Specifications:

Alcohol: 12.0% **pH:** 3.35
Acidity: 6.6g/L **RS:** 4.5g/L

Winemaker's Comments:

Colour: Pale yellow.

Nose: Attractive grapefruit and citrus aromas with pleasant savoury undertones adding complexity.

Palate: A crisp and refreshing palate with good natural acidity. The aromas are reflected in the palate showing citrus characters and an inviting savoury finish.

Cellaring potential: Best enjoyed young. Serve lightly chilled.

Food matches: A great food wine, this will match very well to a roasted vegetable and couscous salad and many types of lightly spiced food. Try also with a cheese and fruit platter - soft and hard cheeses with aromatic characters.
