Grape Variety:
Pinot Noir

Region:
The fruit for this wine was harvested from our estate vineyards located in the Murray Daring, Victoria (60%) and Coonawarra, South Australia (40%).

Harvest Date:
Mid to late March.

Wine Specifications:
Alc/Vol: 13.0% **pH:** 3.39 **Acidity:** 6.1g/l **RS:** 2.0g/L

Vinification:
The wine underwent an extensive period of cold soaking and was then fermented to dryness in static fermenters with twice-daily pump-overs. The wine spent extended time on skins before pressing, racking, MLF, maturation and final blending.

Winemaker's Comments:

Colour:
Medium ruby red.

Nose:
Attractive strawberry, mulberry and red plum fruit aromas with subtle French oak spice and a touch of earthy complexity.

Palate:
Medium bodied, plump and silky, with distinct berry fruit flavours and a savoury, lingering finish.

Cellaring Potential:
Best enjoyed young, but will cellar well for five years.

Ideal Food Matches:
Game meats, charcuterie and mushroom risotto work wonderfully.
