Deakin Estate's family owned vineyards lie near Mildura in north west Victoria. Here, the mighty Murray River weaves across the land, bringing life to the region and to our vines. Rich, fertile soils and a warm, sunny climate also create a perfect environment for growing quality fruit to make these delicious wines.

Varietal: Chardonnay

Region: Murray Darling, Victoria

Harvest Date: Late January -early February 2016

Vinification:

Deakin Estate Chardonnay grapes were harvested when riper flavours were most intense. Several different yeast strains were used to ferment different parcels of fruit which contributed to a variety of fruit and savoury nuances. One parcel was fermented with wild yeast and underwent malolactic fermentation, contributing to some subtle nutty flavours in the final blend.

Cellaring Potential:

Enjoy now but will develop some complexities from short term cellaring. Serve chilled.

Style: Fresh, balanced, elegant

Taste: White peach, pear, hints of citrus

Drink with: Roast chicken, salmon, creamy pasta sauces
