Chardonnay Pinot Grigio 2016



Region: Murray Darling, Victoria.

Varieties: Chardonnay and Pinot Grigio

Harvest: Pinot Grigio - late January, Chardonnay - early to mid-February 2016

Vinification:

Grapes were harvested when the fruit flavours were abundant. Both the Chardonnay and the Pinot Grigio underwent a slow, cool fermentation separately. The final blend was assembled months before bottling to permit the integration of the different flavours.

Alcohol: 13.2% **pH:** 3.36 **Acidity:** 5.6g/L **RS:** <2.0g/L

Pale straw.

Nose:

Attractive orchard fruit and hints of grapefruit with savoury undertones.

A crisp and refreshing wine. A light and persistent palate derived from the Pinot Grigio.
