Shiraz 95% and Viognier 5%

The Viognier was picked ripe and co-fermented with the Shiraz. After clarification the wine was aged in quality French and American oak.

Medium deep red.

**Nose:**

Black cherries, dark plum and orange peel notes with attractive spice and vanilla characters.

Ready to drink now but will develop with short to mid term cellaring.
