

Deakin Estate Moscato 2015

Grape Variety:

Muscat Gordo Blanco

Region:

The fruit for this wine was harvested from our Deakin Estate vineyards in the Murray Darling region of North West Victoria.

Harvest Date:

Late February – early March 2015

Wine Specifications:

Alc/Vol: 6.5% pH: 3.18
Acidity: 5.9g/L RS: 100g/L

Vinification:

Crafted from Muscat Gordo Blanco grapes and fermented with aromatic yeast to accentuate the fruit character. The slow, cool fermentation was arrested early, ensuring the alcoholic content remains low, then blended and stabilised with the utmost care taken to preserve the flavours and aromas.

Colour:

Pale lime-yellow.

Aroma:

Fresh and fruity nose with lifted floral notes, exotic tropical fruit and musk.

Palate:

Light in alcohol. Spritzy and sweet with fresh, natural acidity and a refreshing green apple finish.

Ready to enjoy now. Serve chilled.
