Pinot Noir

Region:
The fruit for this wine was harvested from our estate vineyards located in Coonawarra, South Australia.

Harvest Date:
Mid to late March.

Wine Specifications:
Alc/Vol: 13.0% pH: 3.45 Acidity: 5.9g/l RS: 4.0g/L

Vinification:
The wine underwent an extensive period of cold soaking and was then fermented to dryness in static fermenters with twice-daily pump-overs. The wine spent extended time on skins before pressing, racking, MLF, maturation and final blending.

Colour:
Medium ruby red.

Nose:
Attractive strawberry, mulberry and red plum fruit aromas with subtle French oak spice and a touch of earthy complexity.

Palate:
Medium bodied, plump and silky, with clear berry fruit flavours and a savoury, food-friendly finish.

Cellaring Potential:
Best enjoyed young.

Ideal Food Matches:
Pork loin with horseradish or macadamia stuffed chicken breast would enhance the enjoyment of a glass of this Pinot Noir.
