Vinification: Excellent weather conditions in the lead up to and during harvest allowed estate grown Muscat Gordo Blanco grapes to be picked at optimum sugar and flavour levels.

Half the blend was fermented dry then blended back in, resulting in a fruity, low alcohol, light bodied wine. An aromatic yeast was used to enhance fresh, fruity characters, and very gentle processing followed to preserve as much of the natural spritz as possible. Style: Light, fruity, fresh
