Vinification: Cool pre-ferment maceration and fermentation in sweeping arm potter fermenters with regular pump overs to extract desired colour and tannins. The wine was pressed with a bag press for gentle extraction of tannins and completed malolactic fermentation and maturation for three months on French oak staves.
